Speech pathologists are increasingly aware that Developmental Language Disorder, and Language Disorder associated with other primary conditions, are lifelong disorders. As children reach the upper years of primary school and move into and through secondary education, the world of oral and written language becomes significantly more complex and challenging. Speech pathologists therefore need to embrace a range of interventions that are relevant and effective for their caseloads of older children and adolescents.

Workshop Content

In this highly practical workshop we will be exploring this clinical challenge: How can we best support the oral and written language of older children and adolescents, using current evidence-based practice and the best clinical guidelines? Areas covered will include reading comprehension, written expression and direct vocabulary instruction, as well as how these areas of intervention interrelate.

Learning Objectives

Participants attending the workshop will have an opportunity to:

- Examine the links between oral and written language
- Explore the role of speech pathologists in supporting older children and adolescent clients' oral and written language
- Develop frames of reference, as well as a set of resources, applicable to their clinical practices.
