Intended Participants

This series of two 3.5hr-hour tele-training modules is intended for Speech-Language Therapists working with children whose home language is not English and/or those who have a special interest in providing equitable assessment and treatment for children who speak two or more languages, and experience speech and language difficulties affecting both/all of their languages.

Learning Objectives

Following this event participants will be able to:

- Differentiate typical bilingual language acquisition from language learning difficulties
- Select the appropriate language or language(s) to assess and deliver support to bilingual children
- Work effectively with interpreters to ensure SLT services are delivered in an equitable and effective manner
- Engage and involve bilingual parents and those who have limited English language skills to support their child's communication

Content and Format

Working with children who speak more than one language can be a complex and challenging area of practice. This session will provide participants with knowledge and understanding of bilingualism and best practice in meeting the needs of those whose home language is not English. The workshop will be comprised of lecture style content, interactive discussion and case study discussion.
